CHAPTER 223.

Passed Mar. 9, 1864. AN ACT to refund to Brevard and Dirickson, of Worcester county, the sum of seven dollars and fifty cents, erroneously paid by them into the Treasury of Maryland.

Authorized to pay. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, is hereby authorized and required to pay to Brevard and Dirickson, of Worcester county, seven dollars and fifty cents, erroneously paid by said Brevard and Dirickson into the Treasury.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 224.

Passed March 9, 1864. AN ACT to amend the one hundred and ninety-third section of Article third of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Baltimore county, regulating the compensation of the Sheriff.
