

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 227.

AN ACT to repeal section forty-six, Article sixth, of the Code of Public Local Laws, and to re-enact the same with amendments. Passed Mar. 9, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the forty-sixth section [section] of the sixth Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, fixing the per diem and mileage of the County Commissioners of Caroline county, be and the same is hereby repealed. Repealed.

Sec. 2. *Be it enacted*, That the said County Commissioners shall each be entitled to two dollars for each day's attendance, and five cents a mile for every mile his residence is distant from Denton, such mileage to be computed for each day's attendance. Compensation.
