Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER 325.

Passed Mar. 10, 1864. AN ACT to authorize Charles S. Middleton, former Clerk of the Circuit Court of Prince George's county, to place his fees in the hands of the Sheriff of said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Charles S. Middleton, former Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's county, be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to place all fees due him as Clerk aforesaid in the hands of the Sheriff of said county, and the said Sheriff be and he is authorized and empowered, upon receiving said fees, to collect said fees as all such fees are authorized by law to be collected; and the said Sheriff shall duly account for the same as all such fees due to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for said county are required by law to be accounted for by the Sheriff of said county.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage.
