And be it enacted, That the said company, having perfected the said road aforesaid, it shall and may be lawful for them to appoint such and so many toll-gatherers as they shall think proper, to collect and receive of or from any person or persons using said road the tolls and rate per mile, the same to be regulated by the President and Managers of said company; provided, that the rates and tolls so regulated shall not exceed those of other roads of like nature in this State, and stop any person riding, leading, or driving any horses, mules, oxen, coaches, cart wagon, wain or sled, cattle, hogs, sheep, sulky, chaise, phæton, or other carriage of pleasure or burden from passing through said gates until the tolls for the said passage shall have been paid; provided, that no toll gate shall be erected within one mile from the taxable limits of Liberty Town, or any town or village through which said road may pass.
