

CHAPTER 349.

AN ACT to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from Dulany's Valley to the Little Falls of the Gunpowder. Passed Mar. 10, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a company is hereby incorporated to make a turnpike road, which shall begin at a point on the Dulany's Valley and Towson-town turnpike at or near the Old Stone Tavern and terminate at the Little Falls of the Gunpowder at or near Manor Glen farm. Incorporated.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the capital stock of said company shall be fifty thousand dollars in shares of twenty-five dollars each. Capital stock.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the subscription books of said company shall be opened at Towson-town on or before the first day of June next, for subscriptions for the capital stock of said company, and that John Curtis, John Piersol, George H. Merryman, Benjamin Ridgely, William Price, Joshua Bosley, George Cole and Joshua Hutchings, be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to receive such subscriptions. Books to be opened.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted,* That when two hundred shares of said stock shall have been subscribed, the said Commissioners shall give twenty days notice to the subscribers to meet at a time and place to be fixed by the said Commissioners, for the purpose of organizing said company, and the said subscribers, at such meeting, shall elect a President and five Directors, to serve until the first Monday in January thereafter, and until their successors shall be elected and qualified; and the stockholders of said company shall annually, on the first Monday in January, or within sixty days thereafter, elect a President and five Directors. Notice to be given.

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted,* That the stockholders of said company are hereby created a body politic and corporate by the name of the Dulany's Valley and Little Falls Turnpike Company, and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and shall Name and style of company.
