

well and truly account for all money and other liabilities placed in his hands for collection, and shall well and truly pay all sums of money received by him.

### CHAPTER 357.

Passed Mar. 10, 1864. AN ACT to incorporate the School Sisters of Notre Dame, in the City of Baltimore. •

Incorporated. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Mary Ildephonsa Wegmann, Josephine Fenni, Constantia Schnerr, Evangelesta Meier, Chrisologa Platzter, Sabina Berger and Basilia Bidel, and those who may hereafter become members of the association now and hereby formed by the parties above named, and their successors shall be and they are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the name and style of the School Sisters of Notre Dame, in the City of Baltimore, with perpetual succession, and by that name may sue and be sued, may have and use a common seal, may take, hold, possess, use and enjoy any estate or property, real, personal or mixed, by gift, devise, purchase or otherwise in fee simple, or for less estate, and the same or any part thereof, may lease, sell or convey by deed or otherwise, with full power and authority to collect and receive all debts, rents and dues which may hereafter become due and owing to the said corporation by suit or otherwise, as any natural person may lawfully do; *Provided always*, That the annual income of the property and estate to be acquired and held by said Corporation as aforesaid, shall not at any time exceed the sum of ten thousand dollars, exclusive of any income said Corporation may derive from their school, library and philosophical apparatus.
