

CHAPTER 368.

Passed Mar. 10, 1864. AN ACT to amend section four hundred and ninety-four of Article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled, City of Baltimore, relating to the measurement of Oysters.

Amended and re-enacted. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section four hundred and ninety-four of Article four of the Code of Public Local Laws be amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows: All oysters carried to the city of Baltimore for sale shall be sold by the sealed half bushel, or sealed bushel and half measure, and each and every person offending against the provisions of this section shall be subject to a fine of fifty dollars for each and every offence, to be recovered before a Justice of the Peace of the city of Baltimore, by action of debt in the name of the State of Maryland, one-half to the informer, and the other half to the use of the State.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 369.

Passed Mar. 10, 1864. AN ACT entitled, an act to repeal sections three hundred and three hundred and seven of Article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the inspection of Salted Fish, in the City of Baltimore, and to enact the following in lieu thereof.
