CHAPTER 374.

Passed March 9, 1864. AN ACT making appropriations for the support of the Government for the year ending on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty-six.

Expenditures in support of Government for year ending 1st of January, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That for the expenditures in the support of the Government for the year ending on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same hereby is appropriated, that is to say :

STATE OFFICERS.

Sums appropriated.

For the salary of the Governor of Maryland, three thousand six hundred dollars; for the salary of the Secretary of State, one thousand dollars; for the salary of the Comptroller of the Treasury Department, two thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the Chief Clerk to the Comptroller, fifteen hundred dollars; for the salary of the Assistant Clerk to the Comptroller, one thousand dollars; for the salary of the Treasurer, two thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the Clerk to the Treasurer, fifteen hundred dollars; for the salary of the Private Secretary to the Governor, eight hundred dollars; for the salary of the Commissioner of the Land Office, seven hundred and fifty dollars, including compensation for keeping Chancery Records; for the salary of the Librarian, one thousand dollars; to the Commissioners
