powers of the said company, and shall manage the affairs of the same until the first annual meeting for the election of a Board of Directors, which shall take place on the first Monday in January next, after five hundred shares shall have been not only subscribed, but paid; until which payment of five thousand dollars, no contract shall be made for any part of the railway intended to be made according to the provisions of this act.

Authorized to lay track in streets.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted. That the Commissioners of the town of Easton, be and they are hereby authorized to permit the President and Directors of said company to lay down such tracks as they may desire for the purposes of this act, through any of the streets of said town, and the Commissioners of the county are also authorized to permit, if desired by said company, the use of any of the county roads; provided, that the said company shall pay annually to the Commissioners of said town, ten dollars, and to the Commissioners of the county, the sum of twenty dollars for the purpose of keeping said public roads on which said railways may be located, in due and proper repair.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 377.

AN ACT making appropriations for the support of the Government, for the year ending on the first day of January, eighteen hundred, and sixty-five.

Expenditures in support of Government

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That for the expenditures in the supfor the year port of the Government, for the year ending on the January, 1865. first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixtyfive, the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated, that is to say:
