They shall severally account for, under oath, and pay over to the Treasurer quarterly, all moneys received by them as Inspectors after retaining for their services two thirds of all moneys received under the four hundred and thirteenth section, and one-fifth of all moneys received under the four hundred and twentieth section of this Article, and the Inspector at the Western Scales, shall be allowed a sum not exceeding three hundred dollars annually for an assistant to carry out the additional duties required of him by this act, on proof that such sum has been properly expended by him. To pay quarterly.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 385.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article eighteen of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, "Clerks of Courts," requiring the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city to prepare a General Index of the judgments now standing or hereafter to be rendered in his office. Passed Mar. 10, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a section be added to Article eighteen of the Code of Public General Laws, to take place in said Article immediately after section seventy, as follows: Section added.

70. The Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city is hereby authorized and required to prepare an index of all judgments and decrees, which have been rendered in the Superior Court aforesaid since its organization, the expense of To prepare index.
