

## CHAPTER 398.

AN ACT to authorize and empower Ignatius Waters, surviving Trustee of the Methodist Episcopal Church at Brookville, Montgomery county, to convey and deed to the Board of School Commissioners of said county a part of said church lot for the use of Public Schools. Passed Mar. 10, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Ignatius Waters, surviving Trustee of the Methodist Episcopal Church at Brookville, Montgomery county, be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to convey by deed a portion of said church lot to the Board of Commissioners of Public Schools for the use and benefit of the Public Schools. Authorized to convey a portion of lot.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

## CHAPTER 399.

AN ACT to add a new Article to the Code of Public General Laws, to be entitled, "Theatrical Exhibitions," to provide for the Regulation and Government of such Exhibitions. Passed Mar. 10, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following Article be added to the Code of Public General Laws, under the title of "Theatrical Exhibitions." Article added.

Sec. 2. *Be it enacted,* That it shall not be lawful for any Proprietor, Lessee, or Manager of any Theatre, Museum, or other place of amusement, to employ women or girls as waiters, or to permit them to act in such Theatre, or place of amusement, or among the audience or frequenters of such Theatre, or place of amusement, as waiters or for
