Sec. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 54.

Passed Jan. 22, 1864. AN ACT to refund Charles Shipley taxes erroneously paid.

Preamble. WHEREAS, It appears that Charles Shipley has erroneously paid into the treasury of Baltimore county the sum of fifty-nine dollars and ninety-six cents ; Therefore,

Authorized to refund.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Baltimore county be and they are hereby authorized and directed to refund said Shipley the sum of fifty-nine dollars and ninety-six cents, as taxes erroneously paid, and to make sufficient levy to reimburse therefor.

Sec. 2. *Be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
