

No. 214. An act to authorize the sale of the real-estate of Jacob Ambrose, deceased, late of Frederick county, by Jacob Summers, of J., administrator of said deceased, for the benefit of the persons entitled thereto.

No. 215. An act for the relief of the St. Mary's Female Seminary.

No. 216. An act to make valid certain proceedings of George Moore and Thomas B. Moore, executors of William H. Acworth deceased, late of Somerset county.

No. 217. An act to incorporate the Allegany Land Improvement Company.

No. 218. An act to refund to Samuel F. Butler, certain moneys overpaid by him into the State Treasury.

No. 219. An act for the relief of John Harrison, Tax Collector.

No. 220. An act to provide for the presentation of Regimental Flags to Maryland Regiments in the service of the United States.

No. 221. An act for the benefit and relief of the President and Managers of the High Street Wharf Company.

222. An act to refund to the infant children of Samuel D. Walker, deceased, the tax paid by him on his commission as Flour Inspector.

No. 223. An act to refund to Brevard and Dirickson of Worcester county, the sum of seven dollars and fifty cents erroneously paid by them into the Treasury of Maryland.

No. 224. An act to amend the one hundred and ninety-third section of Article three of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to Baltimore county, regulating the compensation of the Sheriff.

No. 225. A supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Presbyterian Church in the city of Baltimore, passed at November session seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, chapter fifty-eight.

No. 226. An act to amend and re-enact section one hundred and forty-six, section one hundred and fifty-two, and section one hundred and sixty of Article eight of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled, Cecil county, and relating to the village of Port Deposit.
