

Sec. 3. *Be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 58.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to levy a sum of money which in their judgment may be necessary or or ought justly to be paid to Jacob M. Sham-berger and others, so expended by him or them, in the opening of a public county road in the Sixth Election District of Baltimore county. Passed Jan. 25, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Baltimore county are hereby authorized and empowered to adjust the claims of Jacob M. Sham-berger and others, and pay all reasonable expense for opening said road; when thus ascertained the said commissioners shall levy on the assessable property of Baltimore county, at the next general levy, the amount thus agreed. Commission-ers authorized to pay.
