#### CHAPTER 79.

Passed Feb. 5, 1864. AN ACT to refund a sum of money paid into the State Treasury erroneously by John Pettibone, one of the Tax Collectors of Anne Arundel county.

Authorized to pay.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is hereby ordered to pay to John Pettibone, a Collector of State taxes for the second district of Anne Arundel county, for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-one, the sum of three dollars and sixty-one cents, erroneously paid by him into the State Treasury.
