

CHAPTER 80.

AN ACT to revive and amend the act of incorporation of the town of Williamsport; in Washington county, Maryland, passed December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-three, chapter one hundred and twenty-five, with the several supplements thereto. Passed Feb. 5, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the act of incorporation of the town of Williamsport, in Washington county, Maryland, passed December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-three, chapter one hundred and twenty-five, with the several supplements thereto, be and the same is hereby revived and made as effectual to all intents and purposes as if the said act of incorporation had not expired. Revived and make effectual.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the Burgess and Commissioners of said town have power to include within said corporation the public grave yard at Williamsport. Powers of.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after its passage. In force.
