CHAPTER 98.

AN ACT to repeal an act entitled, a further ad-Passed March ditional supplement to an actentitled, an act to establish and incorporate a Medical and Chirurgical Faculty or Society, in the State of Maryland, passed June session eighteen hundred and sixty-one, chapter forty-two, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of members of Maryland, That it shall be fully competent for may transact any number of the members of the Medical and business. Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland, not less than five, who may assemble after a public call published at least twice a week, for two weeks, in one or more of the daily newspapers of Baltimore city. to transact any or all of the business that may come before said Faculty.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That so much of the charter of said Faculty as calls for fifteen to make a quorum to transact the business of said Faculty, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall In force. take effect from and after its passage.
