

CHAPTER 98.

AN ACT to repeal an act entitled, a further ad-^{Passed March 5, 1862.}
ditional supplement to an act entitled, an act to
establish and incorporate a Medical and Chirur-
gical Faculty or Society, in the State of Mary-
land, passed June session eighteen hundred and
sixty-one, chapter forty-two, and to re-enact the
same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly* ^{Any number of members may transact business.}
of Maryland, That it shall be fully competent for
any number of the members of the Medical and
Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland, not less than
five, who may assemble after a public call pub-
lished at least twice a week, for two weeks, in one
or more of the daily newspapers of Baltimore city,
to transact any or all of the business that may
come before said Faculty.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That so much of the ^{Repealed.}
charter of said Faculty as calls for fifteen to make
a quorum to transact the business of said Faculty,
be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall ^{In force.}
take effect from and after its passage.
