

any one of said Commissioners who, during his term of office, shall accept any other place of public trust or emolument, or who, during the same period, shall knowingly receive any nomination for an office elective by the people, without publicly declining the same within twenty days succeeding said nomination, shall be deemed to have thereby vacated his office; for official misconduct, any of the said Commissioners may be removed by a concurrent vote of the two houses of the General Assembly, or by the Governor, during the recess thereof.

Official misconduct; removal of Commissioners, &c.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That section eight hundred and seven of the said Article be and the same is hereby repealed, and that in lieu thereof the following be enacted as a section of said Article:

807. During the present session of the General Assembly two Commissioners shall be elected by joint ballot of the two Houses, and as soon as they shall have been qualified by taking and subscribing to the oaths or affirmations hereinbefore mentioned, they shall cast lots between themselves, and the Commissioner whose name shall be first drawn shall serve from the time of his appointment until the end of two years from and after the tenth day of March next, and until his successor shall have been appointed and qualified; and the other of the said Commissioners shall serve from the time of his appointment until the end of four years from and after the tenth day of March next, and until his successor shall have been appointed and qualified, and when the result of the said ballots shall be ascertained, notice thereof shall be given at once to the Governor, by the Commissioners in writing to be filed in the office of the Secretary of State.

Election of two Commissioners—their tenure of office to be decided by lot, &c.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That section eight hundred and nine of the said Article be and the same is hereby repealed, and that in lieu thereof the following be enacted as a section of said Article:
