CHAPTER 132.

- AN ACT to allow John J. Ogden, late Sheriff of Passed March Calvert county, further time to complete his collections.
- SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Empowered of Maryland, That John J. Ogden, late Sheriff of to collect. Calvert county, be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to collect all fees and claims due him as such Sheriff, in the same manner and as fully, to all intents and purposes, as if the original time allowed by law had not expired.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from the day of its passage, and shall continue in force for two years and no longer.

CHAPTER 133.

- AN ACT to amend section sixty two of Article Passed March eighty-one of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the redemption of Real Estate sold for Taxes.
- SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland That section sixty-two, Article eighty-one, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the redemption of real estate sold for taxes, be and the same is hereby amended and reenacted so as to read as follows:
- Sec. 2. Whenever real estate shall be sold by a Real estate collector, the owner thereof may redeem the same deemed, by the by paying to the purchaser thereof, within the payment of 15 period of two years from the date of such sale, the per ct. interest amount of the purchase money, with interest thereon at the rate of fifteen per cent. per annum from the date of the sale.
- Sec. 3. This act shall go into effect upon its Inforce. passage.
