

CHAPTER 146.

Passed Feb. 25, 1862. AN ACT to amend the sixtieth section of the thirteenth Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the Primary Schools of Howard county.

Repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sixteenth section of the thirteenth Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the Primary Schools of Howard county, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

Books and stationery for schools.

They shall, from time to time, name such books as shall be used in the Primary Schools, and such books shall be uniform in the several schools; and the trustees of each School District shall appropriate out of the school funds of the District, a sum not exceeding thirty dollars a year, for the purchase of books and stationery, under the direction of said inspectors.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER 147.

Passed Feb. 28, 1862. AN ACT to amend the thirty-seventh Article of the Code of Public General Laws, by repealing the thirty-third section thereof, relating to Commissions to take evidence from other States, and substituting therefor a new section.

Repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the thirty-third section of the thirty-seventh Article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Commissions to take evidence from other States, be and the same is hereby re-
