

CHAPTER 149.

AN ACT to change the place of holding Elections in the Tenth Election District of Frederick county. Passed March 4, 1862.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following section be added to Article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Frederick county, to be introduced therein after section three hundred and forty-six: Additional section.

That all elections hereafter to be held in the Tenth Election District of Frederick county, shall be held in the Primary School House of School District number Two in said county, generally known by the name of Smithfield School House. Place of holding elections.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 150.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Hagerstown and Sharpsburg Turnpike Company, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter one hundred and twenty-nine. Passed March 4, 1862.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the charter of the Hagerstown and Sharpsburg Turnpike Company, be and the same is hereby amended by the following addition as section ten of the original act: Amended.

10. *And be it enacted,* That the President and Directors of the Hagerstown and Sharpsburg Turnpike Company are hereby authorized and empowered to erect an additional toll-gate upon said turnpike, and may collect and receive the same rate of tolls as are provided for in the seventh section of said act of incorporation. Authority to erect an additional toll-gate
