CHAPTER 16

Passed Jan. 4, 1862. AN ACT to repeal an act making valid the quali-
fication of John Merryman, as First Lieutenant
of the Baltimore county Horse Guards.

Act repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly
of Maryland*, That the act entitled, An act to make
valid the qualification of John Merryman, as First
Lieutenant of the Baltimore county Horse Guards,
passed on the eighteenth day of June, eighteen
hundred and sixty-one, of the extra session of the
General Assembly of Maryland, chapter forty-
nine, be and the same is hereby repealed.
