

Commissions of Executors to be fixed by the Orphans' Courts. ing be enacted as a substitute therefor: The several Orphans' Courts shall fix the Commissions of Executors, within twelve months from the grant of administration, and in all subsequent accounts, wherein Executors shall charge themselves with further assets; and they shall fix such commissions in all cases in which letters of administration have been or may hereafter be granted, whether commissions are claimed by the Executor or not, and all commissions so fixed, shall be subject to the tax imposed by the foregoing section.

In force. Sec. 2 *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 19.

Passed Jan. 7, 1862. AN ACT to repeal sections four hundred and eighty-six, four hundred and eighty-seven, four hundred and eighty-eight, four hundred and ninety, four hundred and ninety-one, four hundred and ninety-two, and four hundred and ninety-three of Article four of Public Local Laws, relative to the Inspection and Measurement of Manure.

Sections repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections four hundred and eighty-six, four hundred and eighty-seven, four hundred and eighty-eight, four hundred and ninety, four hundred and ninety-one, four hundred and ninety-two, and four hundred and ninety-three of Article four of the Code of the Public Local Laws, relating to the Inspection and Measurement of Manure, be and the same are hereby repealed.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
