

## CHAPTER 191.

AN ACT to change the name of William McKeown, of Howard county, to William Crockett. Passed March 7, 1862.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Name changed That the name of William McKeown, of Howard county, be and the same is hereby changed to William Crockett.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

## CHAPTER 192.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money for the claims of Samson Cariss, James H. League, James Hopkins, Merryman & Young, Dunnett & Finney, Hiss and Austen, W. J. Jewell, James Iglehart, William Wiggins, John Lindenborn, Louis F. Gootee, Whitney, Cushing & Company, Baltimore City Passenger Railway Company, John W. Davis, N. R. Merryman, Thomas McGlannan, William Dadds and Paul Martin. Passed March 8, 1862.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Sums appropriated, &c. That the Comptroller be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay Sampson Cariss, or order, two hundred and eight dollars and fifty cents, for balance due on gilt frame in Senate Chamber; to pay James H. League, or order, one hundred and sixty-one dollars, for hoisting flag on State House by order of the Governor; to James Hopkins, or order, one hundred and forty-eight dollars and fifty cents, for painting and repairs in Senate Chamber and House of Delegates; to Merryman & Young, or order, ninety-two dollars for ventilators in Sen-
