CHAPTER 205.

AN ACT to allow Alexander Woolford, Sheriff of Dorchester county, further time to execute his official bond. Passed March 8, 1862.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Alexander Woolford, Sheriff of Dorchester county, be and he is hereby allowed until the first day of May next to execute his official bond. Time allowed to execute official bond.
