- Passed Jan. AN ACT to repeal the first, second and seventh sections of Article fifty-two of the Public General Laws, relating to the Keeper of Chancery Records, and to enact the following as a substitution therefor.
 - Repealed. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the first section of Article fifty-two of the Public General Laws, relating to the Keeper of Chancery Records, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted as a substitute therefor:
- Chancery Records.

 SECTION 1. The Commissioner of the Land Office, shall have charge of the Records of the Court of Chancery, and the anti-revolution papers now in the Chancery Office, and shall discharge the duties hereinafter specified.
- Repealed.

 And be it enacted, That the second section of Article fifty-two of the Public General Laws, relating to the Keeper of Chancery Records, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:
- Sec. 2. He shall, for the performance of said duties, receive the sum of five hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly out of the Treasury.
 - And be it enacted, That the seventh section of Article fifty-two of the Public General Laws, relating to the salary of the Keeper of Chancery Records, be and the same is hereby repealed.
 - In force. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
