

CHAPTER 212.

AN ACT to refund to Rebecca T. Neill a certain sum of money therein named, paid by her for composition on a patent granted to her for certain lands in Baltimore county. ^{Passed March 10, 1862.}

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer of the State be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to Rebecca T. Neill the sum of one thousand and twenty-one dollars and thirty-five cents, being the amount paid by her for composition on a patent for certain land in Baltimore county. ^{Treasurer authorized to pay.}

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. ^{In force.}

CHAPTER 213.

AN ACT for the relief of Robert Clark one of the sureties on the official bonds of Thomas C. Lyles and William Lyles (of Thomas) former collectors of Prince George's county. ^{Passed March 7, 1862.}

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Robert Clark, one of the sureties on the official bonds of Thomas C. Lyles and William Lyles (of Thomas) as collectors of taxes in Prince George's county, be and he is hereby released from all further responsibility to the State on account of said bonds, *provided however,* that the principal and other sureties on said bonds and their property shall in no manner be released therefrom. ^{Released from responsibility on account of bonds. Proviso.}

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage. ^{In force.}
