

CHAPTER 214.

Passed March 8, 1862. AN ACT to repeal sections one hundred and eighteen, one hundred and nineteen, one hundred and twenty-one, one hundred and twenty-two, one hundred and twenty-three, one hundred and twenty-four, one hundred and twenty-five, one hundred and twenty-six, one hundred and twenty-seven, one hundred and twenty-eight, one hundred and twenty-nine, one hundred and thirty, one hundred thirty-one, one hundred and thirty-two and one hundred and thirty-three of Article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws, under the title of Sheep.

Repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections one hundred and eighteen, one hundred and nineteen, one hundred and twenty-one, one hundred and twenty-two, one hundred and twenty-three, one hundred and twenty-four, one hundred and twenty-five, one hundred and twenty-six, one hundred and twenty-seven, one hundred and twenty-eight, one hundred and twenty-nine, one hundred and thirty, one hundred and thirty-one, one hundred and thirty-two and one hundred and thirty-three, of Article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws, be and the same are hereby repealed.
