

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall ^{In force.} take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 219.

AN ACT to compensate Randall and Hagner and ^{Passed March 10, 1862.} William Price, for legal services rendered by order of the Governor.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller be and he is ^{Authority to pay.} hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay Randall and Hagner, or order, one hundred dollars, for legal services rendered by order of the Executive, in the case of the Comptroller *vs.* the Governor; and, also, to pay William Price one thousand dollars, and Randall and Hagner one thousand dollars, for legal services rendered in the case of the State *vs.* the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company, by order of the Governor; and, also, to pay William Price, for legal services rendered by order of the Governor, in the case of the State *vs.* St. John's College, five hundred dollars.

CHAPTER 220.

AN ACT to compensate Milton Whitney for legal services rendered by order of the Governor. ^{Passed March 10, 1862.}

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller be and he is ^{Authority to pay.} hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the
