

First Congressional district.

80. The first Congressional district shall be composed of Worcester county, Somerset county, Dorchester county, Talbot county, Caroline county, Queen Anne's county, Kent county, and Cecil county, and shall be entitled to choose one Representative.

Second Congressional district.

81. The second Congressional district shall be composed of Harford county, the fifth, sixth, seventh, ninth, tenth, eleventh, and twelfth districts of Baltimore county, and the first seven wards of Baltimore city, and shall be entitled to choose one Representative.

Third Congressional district.

82. The third Congressional district shall be composed of the wards of Baltimore city, from the eighth to the twentieth, inclusive, and shall be entitled to choose one Representative.

Fourth Congressional district.

83. The fourth Congressional district shall be composed of Allegany county, Washington county, Frederick county, and Carroll county, and shall be entitled to choose one Representative.

Fifth Congressional district.

84. The fifth Congressional district shall be composed of St. Mary's county, Charles county, Calvert county, Anne Arundel county, with the city of Annapolis, Prince George's county, Montgomery county, Howard county, and the first, second, third, fourth, eighth, and thirteenth districts of Baltimore county, and shall be entitled to choose one Representative.

Separate returns.

85. The return judges of the elections of Representatives to Congress of the first, second, third, fourth, eighth, and thirteenth districts of Baltimore county shall make a return separate from the return to be made by the return judges of the remaining seven districts, and the return judges of the first seven wards of the city of Baltimore shall make a return separate from the return to be made by the judges of the remaining thirteen wards.
