Sec. 3. That the Comptroller be and is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer, to pay William H. Dallam, or his order, one hundred dollars, for legal services rendered by order of the Governor, in the case of the State *versus* A. L. Jarrett and Sprigg Harwood.

Sec. 4. That the Comptroller be and is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer, to pay Henry Stockbridge, or his order, one hundred dollars, for expenses incurred and services rendered by order of the Governor, in the recovery of the State arms.

Sec. 5. That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

### CHAPTER 233.

AN ACT to compensate Thomas S. Alexander for professional services rendered by him, under appointment by the Governor, in the Circuit Court for Harford county, sitting in equity, and in the Court of Appeals, in the case of the State of Maryland *vs.* A. Lingan Jarrett and Sprigg Harwood. Passed March 10, 1862.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant on the Treasurer to pay Thomas S. Alexander, or his order, the sum of four hundred dollars for professional services rendered by him, under appointment of the Governor, in the Circuit Court for Harford county, sitting in equity, and in the Court of Appeals, in the case of the State of Maryland against A. Lingan Jarrett and Sprigg Harwood. Sum appropriated, &c.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the passage thereof. In force.
