other cases of appeals from judgments of Justices of the Peace.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall Inforce. take effect after the first day of April next.

CHAPTER 239.

AN ACT to amend section one hundred and s, 1862.
eighty-eight of Article one of the Code of Public Local Laws for Allegany county, relating to Wild Animals in said county.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one hundred and eighty-eight of Article one, of the Code of Public Local Laws for Allegany county, relating to Wild Animals in said county, be repealed, and the following section substituted therefor:

188. Any citizen of this State, who shall kill or Allowance for destroy any wolf, panther, wild cat or fox, within panthers, wild the limits of Allegany county, shall be entitled cats, and foxes. to the following allowance, to wit:

For each wolf's scalp, the sum of twenty dollars; for each wild cat's scalp, the sum of one dollar and fifty cents; for each fox scalp, the sum of one dollar; and for each panther's scalp, the sum of five dollars.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall Inforce. take effect from the day of its passage.
