due notice to remove the same shall have been given.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, if any person shall Dams, reservoirs, &c. injure or cause to be injured, defaced or destroyed, any dam, reservoir, line of conduit, water pipe, gate-house, stop cock, or other thing, used for supplying the city of Baltimore with water, the person so offending shall forfeit and pay a sum not less than five, nor more than fifty dollars for each offence.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That all fines and Fines and feitures—how forfeitures imposed by this act, shall be recoverable recoverable. by warrant, before any Justice of the Peace, in and for the city of Baltimore, or in and for Baltimore county, according to the respective jurisdiction under which any of the offences herein set forth may be committed; one-half to the informer, and the other half to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall Construction. not be construed to exempt any person or persons who may have been fined for a violation thereof, or who may be charged with a violation thereof, from an action of damages for any injury or destruction of any part of the works used in supplying the city of Baltimore with water, in any suit for damages on account of said injury, brought by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore.

Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That this act shall In force. take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER 241.

AN ACT for the protection of Fish in all Creeks Passed March and Streams of Water, and their tributaries, in 8, 1862. Frederick county.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Throwing lime of Maryland, That any person or persons throw-substances in ing, putting or placing lime, or any other poison-creeks, &c., ous substances, into any of the creeks, streams of forbidden.
