## BALTIMORE CITY.

To the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, as per Article four, section one hundred and twenty-seven, Public Local Laws, twenty thousand dollars; to the Maryland Institute for the promotion of the Mechanic Arts, five hundred dollars; to the members of the appeal tax court of Baltimore city, one hundred and fifty dollars; to the register of Baltimore city, three hundred dollars; to the Maryland Penitentiary, for so much on account of the salaries of its officers, eight thousand dollars; for the support of the Maryland Penitentiary, twenty thousand dollars; to the House of Refuge, ten thousand dollars; to the Home of the Friendless, three thousand dollars.

## WAR TAX.

To pay the United States War Tax, assumed by the State, one million one hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars.

## PUBLIC DEBT.

To the payment of bonds, issued under act of eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter two hundred and thirty-eight, five hundred dollars; to the payment of the interest on the public debt of this State, that is to say: the interest falling due quarterly on the currency debt of the State, four hundred and twenty thousand dollars; and the interest on public debt falling due semi-annually, and payable in London, including the cost of exchange, remittance and commissions, two hundred and sixty thousand dollars; for interest on the Maryland Defence Loan, to January eighteen hundred and sixty-three, forty thousand dollars; *provided, however*, that all that portion of the interest on the public debt, which at any time during the year ending on the first day of
