Hand, Editor Maryland Citizen, twenty dollars; *provided*, that the Comptroller shall find that the advertisements were properly authorized, and the amounts charged are correct; for Edwin M. Shipley, four hundred dollars for making Catalogue of the State Library; for J. A. Dushane, nine hundred and thirty-eight dollars for binding the Laws and Journals of the Extra Session of the Legislature held at Frederick; for James S. Waters, one hundred and eight dollars, seventy-five cents, for sundries for use of the Librarian; for Robert F. Bonsal, one hundred sixty-eight dollars for printing the Catalogue for the Librarian; for C. A. S. Wolf, twenty dollars for repairing clock in the Court of Appeals.
