

## CHAPTER 32.

Passed Feb. 4, 1862. AN ACT to change the name of Francis Hoofman to Francis Hoofman Pelzer.

Name changed SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the name of Francis Hoofman, of Woodensbürg, of Baltimore county, be and the same is hereby changed to Francis Hoofman Pelzer.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall have effect from the passage thereof.

## CHAPTER 33.

Passed Feb. 4, 1862. AN ACT to repeal section seventy-five of Article seventeen of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the salary of the Clerk of the Commissioners of Queen Anne's County, and substitute therefor the following section.

Section repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section seventy-five of Article seventeen of the Code of Public Local Laws be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following section substituted therefor :

Salary of clerk to commissioners. 75. The County Commissioners are hereby authorized to pay their Clerk annually, as a compensation for his services, such sum as they may deem proper, not to exceed three hundred dollars.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
