CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT to amend sections thirteen and fifteen, of Passed Jan. Article ninety-eight, of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, Wild Fowl, relating to the catching and killing of Partridges, Woodcock and Pheasants.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Sec. 13, art. of Maryland, That section thirteen, of Article 98, amended ninety-eight, of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, Wild Fowl, be amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

No person shall trap, shoot, or in any manner. The killing, catch or kill any Partridges, between the fifteenth sons, of Parday of January and the twentieth of October, tridges, Woodnor any Woodcock, between the first day of Feb-cock and Pheasuary and the tenth day of June, nor any Pheased. ants, between the first day of February and the twelfth day of August, in each year.

Sec. 2. That section fifteen of said Article, be Section 15 amended and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

Any person violating either of the preceding sections, shall pay a fine of five dollars, to be recovered before a Justice of the Peace of the county where the offence was committed, which fine shall be paid to the County. Commissioners for the county in which the case shall be tried, for the use of the common school fund.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect from the day of In force. its passage.
