

CHAPTER 45.

AN ACT to change the name of William Perry Brinning to that of William Perry Boward. Passed Jan. 23, 1862.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the name of William Perry Brinning, of Hagerstown, Washington county, Maryland, be and the same is hereby changed to that of William Perry Boward. Name changed

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the passage thereof. In force.

CHAPTER 46.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money for the repairs of the Government House, and for the purchase of furniture therefor. Passed Jan. 22, 1862.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of four thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the repair of the Government House, and for the purchase of furniture therefor. Appropriation.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized to have the Government House repaired in such manner and of such material as will in his opinion be most desirable and economical, and also to purchase such furniture therefor as he may deem necessary for comfort and convenience, and to draw upon the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, who is hereby directed to issue the same, for the said sum of four thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be required for said purposes. Authority to repair Government House.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage. In force.
