provided, the amount paid therefor, in any one provided, shall not exceed the sum of one thousand dollars, and that no out-pension shall be allowed to any person who is not a fit subject to be received into the Alms House.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall Inforce. take effect from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 51.

AN ACT to change the place of holding the Elec- Passed Jan. tions in the Fifth Election District of Baltimore 31, 1862. county.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Place of holdof Maryland, That the place for holding elections in the fifth district in Baltimore county, shall be at the house where Daniel Wilhelm now resides, on the Falls Road, in said district.

Sec. 2. Be it enacted, That this act shall take In force. effect from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 52.

AN ACT to refund to Samuel T. Hopkins and Passed Feb. John Donovan certain monies overpaid by them 1, 1861. into the State Treasury.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Treasurer of Maryland, That the Treasurer be and he is authorized to hereby authorized and directed, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to pay to Samuel T. Hopkins, Clerk of the Circuit Court for Talbot county, the sum of two hundred and thirty-six dollars and twenty-six cents; and to John Donovan, late Re-
