Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 51.

AN ACT to change the place of holding the Elections in the Fifth Election District of Baltimore county. Passed Jan. 31, 1862.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the place for holding elections in the fifth district in Baltimore county, shall be at the house where Daniel Wilhelm now resides, on the Falls Road, in said district. Place of holding elections.

Sec. 2. *Be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 52.

AN ACT to refund to Samuel T. Hopkins and John Donovan certain monies overpaid by them into the State Treasury. Passed Feb. 1, 1861.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and directed, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to pay to Samuel T. Hopkins, Clerk of the Circuit Court for Talbot county, the sum of two hundred and thirty-six dollars and twenty-six cents; and to John Donovan, late Re- Treasurer authorized to pay.
