

CHAPTER 67.

Passed Feb. 19, 1862. AN ACT to appropriate a certain sum of money for the benefit of the First Regiment of the Potomac Home Brigade.

Appropriation SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of twenty-six hundred and twenty-seven dollars and seventy-eight cents, be and the same is hereby appropriated to defray the expense incurred in the purchase of India Rubber Blankets and cap Covers for the First Regiment of the Potomac Home Brigade, and that the State Treasurer shall upon the warrants of the Comptroller of the Treasury, pay to Lewis Ramsburg, Secretary of the Frederick Town Savings Institution, the sum of thirteen hundred and thirteen dollars and eighty-nine cents, and to Andrew Henderson, Secretary of the Franklin Savings Bank, the like sum of thirteen hundred and thirteen dollars and eighty-nine cents, in full of said sum of twenty-six hundred and twenty-seven dollars and seventy-eight cents.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 68.

Passed Feb. 19, 1862. AN ACT to provide for the filling of vacancies in office by the Governor, in all cases not otherwise provided by the Constitution and Laws of this State.

Governor authorized to fill all vacancies in office. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That in all cases of vacancies in office which now exist or may hereafter exist, for the filling of which no provision has been made by the Constitution or Laws of this State, the Gov-
