CHAPTER 69.

AN ACT supplementary to an act entitled, An act to incorporate the Isabella Gas Works of Frederick city. Passed Feb. 10, 1862.

WHEREAS, in consequence of the sale of the property of the Isabella Gas Works, the number of Stockholders is not sufficient at this time to constitute a Board of Directors under the said act of incorporation, passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, at its January session, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter two hundred and thirty-four; *and whereas*, Charles E. Trail, Jacob M. Kunkel and William T. Brown, the purchasers of said Works, are also the holders and owners, by regular transfer and assignment, of all the stock of said Isabella Gas Works, and the public convenience, as well as that of said purchasers, will be promoted by continuing to said purchasers the rights, privileges and franchises, granted by said act of incorporation, of the Isabella Gas Works of Frederick city; Therefore, Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Charles E. Trail, Jacob M. Kunkel and William T. Brown, and all such persons as shall associate with them by becoming Stockholders in the manner hereinafter provided, their successors and assigns, shall be and they are hereby made and constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name, title and style of "The Isabella Gas Works," and as such, shall be entitled to, and shall have, possess and enjoy, all the rights, privileges, powers and immunities and Incorporated.
