CHAPTER 78.

AN ACT to amend section eighty-one of Article seven of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the Sheriff of Carroll county. Passed Feb. 26, 1862.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section eighty-one of Article seven of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the Sheriff of Carroll county, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Amended.

Sec. 81. The Sheriff of Carroll county shall be entitled to thirty-three and one-third cents per day for boarding each prisoner or person committed to or confined in the jail of said county. Price of board for jail prisoners.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 79.

AN ACT to make valid an instrument of writing from George P. Leatherbury and Virginia Leatherbury, his wife. Passed Feb. 26, 1862.
