

CHAPTER 84.

Passed Feb. 28, 1862. AN ACT to add a section to Article nine of the Public Local Laws of this State, relating to Schools, providing for the disbursement of the fund applicable to the Primary Schools of Charles county.

Disbursement of funds applicable to primary schools authorized.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all sums of money receivable and applicable to the Primary Schools of Charles county, be and the same shall hereafter be disbursed under the direction of the School Commissioners of said county, and that all checks or orders hereafter drawn by said Commissioners shall be countersigned by the Register of Wills of said county, for which the said Register shall receive the sum of ten cents, to be paid by the applicant therefor, for every such order or draft drawn by said Commissioners and signed by him.

In force.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER 85.

Passed March 4, 1862. AN ACT to authorize Hester Twilley and Dewitt C. Handley, administrators with the will annexed of James D. Twilley, late of Dorchester county, deceased, to cut and sell wood and timber from the lands belonging to the estate of said deceased, for the purpose of paying the debts thereof.

Administrators authorized to cut and sell timber, &c.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Hester Twilley and Dewitt C. Handley, administrators with the will annexed of James D. Twilley, late of Dorchester county, deceased, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, to cut and sell from the lands belong-
