any license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at any place in Petersville, District No. 12, in Frederick County, except in the village of Knoxville, in said district, and to prevent the sale of all kinds of intoxicating drinks in the above described limits," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

- SEC. 2. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That it shall not be lawful for the Clerk of the Circuit Court. for Frederick County to issue a license or licenses to any person or persons or body corporate to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at any place in Petersville Election District, No. 12, in the said County. And it shall not be lawful for any person or persons or body corporate to sell any spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at any place in Petersville Election District, No. 12, in said County; and any person or persons or body corporate selling any kind of intoxicating drinks within said Petersville Election District, No. 12 shall be liable to indictment by the Grand Jury, and shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars and costs for the first offense, and for each subsequent offense not less than one hundred dollars nor more than two hundred dollars and costs, and upon failure to pay the same shall be committed to the County jail until such fines and costs are paid, oruntil discharged by due process of law; and one-half of the said fine imposed under this Act shall be paid to the informer, and the other half shall be paid to the Board of School Commissioners of Frederick County for the benefit of the public schools in the said Petersville Election District, No. 12.
- SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the term "Petersville Election District, No. 12," used in this Act shall be construed to include the village of Knoxville as well as any other town, village or place within the limits of said Election District.
- SEC. 4. And be it finally enacted, That this Act shall take effect from and after the thirtieth day of April, 1914.
