

the sum of two hundred and twenty-five dollars annually in full payment and compensation for their services in holding all elections in any one year in said Prince George's County in pursuance of any Public General or Public Local Law of the State of Maryland; said salaries to be paid by the County Commissioners of Prince George's County, Maryland, in the manner now prescribed by law; provided that all Public General and Public Local Laws of Maryland inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed in so far as the same relate to or affect Prince George's County, Maryland.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 610.

AN ACT to create a special taxing area or district and to be known as Section 2 and part of Section 1 of the village of Chevy Chase, Montgomery County, Maryland, and to authorize, empower and direct the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County, upon the request of a majority of those present at meetings of the registered and qualified voters residing in said area, to make special annual levies of not less than twenty (20) cents nor more than fifty (50) cents on each one hundred (100) dollars of the assessable property of the said part of the village of Chevy Chase, within certain boundaries, for the purpose of opening, improving, repairing and lighting the streets, roads, lanes, alleys, sidewalks, parking, drainage, sewerage, sanitation and other village improvements, and for furnishing police protection, clerical and other public service, including the removal of ashes, garbage and other refuse, and the disposal thereof; for the employment of a building inspector to enforce the requirements of all conveyances of land situated in said village and the promulgation of building and other regulations; for the incorporation, election and succession of a Citizens' Committee, who shall appoint a Treasurer to receive and disburse said funds; also directing the said Board of County Commissioners to pay over to said Treasurer of said village for disbursement for opening, improving, maintaining and repairing the county roads, streets and lanes the money collected on account of the county road tax in the same amount and manner as is
