material and quality thereof of which said connection shall be made.

And the laying, building, opening, enlarging, regulating, paving, repairing and maintaining of any sewer, drain or gutter shall be considered as a public improvement within the meaning of Section 158-R of this Act.

158-O. And be it enacted, That the Mayor and Council of Salisbury shall have power and authority to establish, own, control, operate, maintain and manage any one or more of the following named public utilities, to wit: a wharf for the use of the said City; a public market; a plant or plants, a system or systems for supplying water or light or both to and for the said City and the inhabitants thereof. And the said The Mayor and Council of Salisbury shall have power to provide by ordinance for the establishing, owning, controlling, operating, maintaining and managing of such public utilities of any one or more of them, provided, however, that the provisions of Section 132 of the Charter of Salisbury shall apply to the purchase or sale of any such property.

The Mayor and Council of Salisbury shall have power to purchase or to condemn as hereinafter provided, any property of any description whatsoever, in fee or otherwise, for the purpose of establishing, owning, controlling, operating, maintaining or managing any such public utility and such purpose shall be deemed to be a public improvement within the meaning of Section 158-R of the Charter of Salisbury.

- SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That three new Sections be, and the same are hereby added to Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Wicomico County," sub-title "Salisbury," to read as follows, that is to say:
- 138-A. And be it enacted. (a) It shall be the duty of the Mayor and Council of Salisbury to provide for each City and Primary election suitable place or places for voting suitable ballot boxes and ballots in the form and arranged as provided in Section fifty-five (55) of Article thirty-three (33) of the Annotated Code (1912) of Maryland, except that such ballots shall contain the name of every candidate whose nomination has been certified to and filed according to the provisions of this Act.
- (b) That no person shall be a candidate for any public office in the government of the City of Salisbury unless such person shall be nominated either by a primary election held as herein-
