shall be in substance as follows: Residing at...... in the City (or County) of .....in the State of Maryland, do solemnly swear, (or affirm) that I am a legal voter in the said State, that I will support the Constitution of the United States, and that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to the State of Maryland and support the Constitution and Laws thereof, and that I will faithfully and honestly discharge the duties of an officer of registration and judge of election (or clerk of election) for the ...... Precinct of the County, in the State of Maryland, according to the best of my ability, and I do further swear (or affirm) that I will not attempt to ascertain, save in cases and in the manner on which I am authorized by law so to do, for what candidate or candidates any person shall vote or has voted on any question which may be or may have been submitted to the vote of the people, and if such knowledge shall be acquired by me, I will not, directly, or indirectly, by word or act, divulge or reveal the same or aid in doing so, save when I am required to do so by law in some legal proceedings.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 728.

An Act to repeal Section 25 of Chapter 178 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland passed in 1896, entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Town of Ridgely, Caroline County, Maryland," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 25 of Chapter 178 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed in 1896, entitled "An Act to incorporate the town of Ridgely, Caroline County, Maryland," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

SEC. 25. And be it enacted, That the said Commissioners may pass such by-laws and ordinances, as they shall deem necessary for the good government of said town, and the inhabitants
