SEC. 9. Chapter 40 of the Acts of 1910 and Chapter 325 of the Acts of 1890 are hereby repealed and so much of Sections 1, 3, 4, 5 and 8 of the said Chapter 40 of the Acts of 1910, and so much of Sections 1, 3, 4, 5 and 8 of said Chapter 325 of the Acts of 1890, as may not be inconsistent with this Act are hereby re-enacted.

SEC. 10. This Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 102.

AN ACT to repeal Section 97-P of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Talbot County," sub-title "Easton," as passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at the January Session of 1906, Chapter 458, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 97-P of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Talbot County," sub-title "Easton," as passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at the January Session of 1906, Chapter 458, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

97-P. The room in the town building on Harrison street shall be known and used as the Council room, provided, however, the Mayor and Council, by ordinance or resolution, may provide, designate and use any other room in the town of Easton as a City Hall and Council room.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
